Reconfirmation Meeting for October 2020

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
NCAS is open for face to face instruction. We have seen an increase of students choosing virtual learning since we have had positive cases in the district. The First Grade class had to quarantine from Oct. 19th - Oct. 30th. We are in Phase 4, which requires masks for all students and staff.
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
GSRP: Face to Face Instruction, with the exception of a class quarantine, to which virtual learning occurred. GSRP students will return face to face on Nov. 2, 2020.
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Face to Face Instruction, with the exception of first grade who had to quarantine. First grade students were receiving their instruction in a virtual format with some synchronous and asynchronous learning. All first graders returned to face to face instruction on Oct. 30th.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Face to Face Instruction
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Face to Face Instruction
