Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
NCAS is open for face to face instruction for elementary students PreK-5th grade. We have HS/MS attending virtual instruction through Dec. 18th to accommodate the strong consideration from the health department and order by the governor. All students PreK-12 were virtual on Dec. 21 & 22nd. On Jan. 4th, PreK-12 students were able to return to face to face instruction. We remain in Phase 4, which requires masks for all students and staff.
