Dear Parents/ Guardians/ and Students:

We are in a unique time. As the governor stated in her Executive Order all schools must have an approved plan for education for their student body, set up a food program for families that want assistance, along with social and emotional support for families during these trying times.

As you are aware, we do have a licensed counselor that is available to everyone in the Jets family at no cost to you. If you feel that your family needs support please let us know. Along with that, if you haven't signed up for the meal program yet and would like meals please let us know. Our great staff has made and delivered over 18,000 meals since the crisis has begun.

There are many rumors circulating with regards to the closure of face to face contact at school. Under the Executive Order we must still provide an education to our students. It doesn't look like a normal classroom and we are acknowledging that. If your child has internet access their teachers have been posting assignments, please have them check their email. If you don't have internet access paper copies are available.

Since this crisis caught everyone off guard, think of this as our trial run to workout all the issues with distance learning, so if this happens again, everyone will be prepared. ***Because this is a work in progress, during these trying times, North Central will be giving credit or no credit for the second semester. If your child attempts to do assignments presented to them, they will get passing marks. If no attempts are made to complete tasks or assignments, then your child will receive no credit.***

We understand these are trying times, keeping your children on a schedule or routine will help to provide normalcy for them. Set aside an hour or two a day to have your children work on assignments. If your child has questions, please reach out to their teachers who are willing and ready to help.
